Reopen the Saudi corruption inquiry



Dear Prime Minister,

We, the undersigned, are alarmed by the UK Government's curtailment of the Serious Fraud Office's investigation into BAE Systems' arms deals with Saudi Arabia. The decision followed extensive lobbying by BAE, amid reports that the SFO investigation was threatening its £10 billion deal to sell Eurofighter jets to the repressive Saudi regime. The Government's intervention sends a clear message that BAE is above the law and highlights the company's insidious and undemocratic relationship with the Government.

We call on the Government to stop putting BAE's interests before those of the public, to implement effective anti-corruption measures and to reopen the SFO corruption investigation.
